For the first time since 2021, the Hemmings Great Race presented by Coker Tire routed a leg of their annual road rally through this region of Kentucky, passing through Preston, Salt Lick, and Morehead, before stopping last Thursday evening in Charleston, West Virginia. The 10-day, 2300-mile race began June 21 in St. Paul, Minnesota, with the finish line in Irmo, South Carolina, on Sunday. The winners of this year's Great Race were father and son team Jeff and Eric Fredette, driving a 1933 Ford pick-up truck. The rally determines the winner by measuring time, speed, and endurance across nine stages of the race's course. All of the vehicles taking part in the race are classic cars with no modern equipment, and competitors must only use maps and directions provided to navigate. The Fredette's take home the \$50,000 cash prize out of a field of 125 cars this year.
