

Target and Ulta part ways

NEW YORK (AP) Target and Ulta Beauty are parting ways, ending a partnership launched in 2021 that created in-store shops filled with beauty products at hundreds of the discounter's stores. According to a joint

release issued Thursday, the companies said they have "mutually agreed" not to renew their pact, which concludes in August 2026. Until then, the Ulta Beauty experience at Target will continue in Target stores and on Target.com, the release

Ulta is currently in 600 of Target's roughly 1,980 stores, according to a Target spokesperson.

"For 35 years, Ulta Beauty has revolutionized how people experience beauty — bringing together an unmatched assortment from mass to luxury — and our partnership with Target was one of many unique ways we have brought the power of beauty to guests nationwide," said Amiee Bayer-Thomas, chief retail officer of Ulta Beauty, in a state-

ment. Rick Gomez, executive vice president and chief commercial officer at Target, said in a statement he was committed to "offering the beauty experience consumers have come to expect

from Target." The partnership was announced in 2020 and came as the coronavirus pandemic upended shopping habits and more people tried to minimize potential exposure to the virus through one-

stop shopping. COVID had dampened sales of lipstick as people wore masks, but the skincare business enjoyed stronger sales. The shops are about 1,000 square feet and

carry makeup, skincare, and fragrance and operated beside existing beauty sections in Target stores. The deal was a way for both Target and Ulta to increase their customer base.

"It's a combination of two winning retailers that have great momentum in the market that can redefine the category" Target CEO Brian Cornell told The Associated Press back in 2020.

The announcement comes as Target is struggling to regain its footing with its shoppers who are pulling back on discretionary items and are shopping at other rivals that they believe to be lower price or offer

better merchandise. Target is slated to report its fiscal second-quarter results on Wednesday.

In September 2022, Target extended its contract for its chairman and CEO Brian Cornell for another three years. It has not announced its succession plan.

this data project, so we still have a long way to go before we can make any meaningful data conclusions. But what we do know, and what we affirm each year with this project, is that one life harmed by intimate partner violence is one too many, and we'll continue our work until that number is zero."

Later this year, ZeroV will release its best practices and policy recommendations to support ongoing data collection efforts. ZeroV will complete its full review of the report this fall and publish its list of findings on Nov. 1. The organization released its second set of best practices and policy recommendations in November 2024.

PUBLIC NOTICE ORDINANCE NO. 17, 2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY FOR THE TAX YEAR 2025 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATER-CRAFTS; ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATE AT .3500 FOR EACH \$100.00 OF TAXABLE PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Catlettsburg, Kentucky in compliance with Chapter 132 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and other applicable law has determined the tax rate for the taxable year 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY

OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY: SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied an ad valorem tax on all motor vehicles and watercraft, within the City of Catlettsburg, Kentucky, subject to taxation for general revenue purposes at a rate

of .3500 per \$100.00 of taxable property for the tax year 2025. SECTION 2. This Ordinance and the rate set herein is contemplated to and does comply with all provisions of Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 132, and all other applicable law.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are specifically hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict only. SECTION 4. That each section and each sentence of this

Ordinance is enacted separately and the invalidity and/or unconstitutionality of any one particular sentence and/or section.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be given full force and effect and become effective at either its date of publication or such effective date as is stated within the body of the Ordinance.
