The Edmonson County Fiscal Court hereby announces that it has held its second reading of EC25-22, which is an Ordinance relating to reducing the speed limit on Rolling Way from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The Edmonson County Fiscal Court held a public hearing on August 25, 2025 at 3:45 p.m. at the Edmonson County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax rate levied last year was 12.6 and produced revenues in the amount of \$1,184,027.

This year's compensating rate is 11.8 and will produce revenues in the amount \$1,228,227. The Edmonson County Fiscal Court proposed a tax rate of 12.2 which will produce a total of \$1,269,862 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$41,037; revenue expected from Personal Property is\$100,402; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$218,758; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$25,884.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for General Fund utilization for Edmonson County Fiscal Court expenses.

The Kentucky General Assembly requires that the Edmonson County Fiscal Court publish this notice with the above information contained herein.
