ELLIOTT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TAX LEVY HEARING

The Elliott County Board of Education will hold a public hearing, in the Multipurpose Room located in the Board of Education Office Building on March 20, 2025 at 6PM to hear public comments regarding a proposed general fund tax levy of 51.8 cents on real property and 51.8 cents on personal property.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2024 was 44 cents on real property and 44 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$876,775. The proposed General Fund tax rate of 51.8 cents on real property and 51.8 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$1,137,232.23. Of this amount \$206,910.64 is from new and personal property. The compensating tax for 2025 is 43.2 cents on real property and 44 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$951,293.41.

The general areas to which revenue of \$260,457.23 above 2024 revenue is to be allocated are as follows: Building fund, \$143,273.80 and instruction, \$117,636.84.

INVITATION TO BID

The Elliott County Board of Education will be accepting bid guotes for the following in the Jess Adkins Gymnasium stage area:

- Remove existing ceiling tiles, tracking, cable and take to landfill
- Relocate electrical lines, internet cables, duct work, and vent covers.
- Replace old damaged electrical wire above and underneath stage
- Coordinate electrical inspection by the Commonwealth Kentucky
- Remove existing stage floor covering
- Remove all debris from underneath stage and take to landfill.
- Pour concrete pads in center underneath stage 36"x 36" rebar steel.
- Install beams underneath stage 2"x 12" center to match existing beam that were pre-started.
- Install beams on the front and back of stage, cap blocks, 4"x 6" and 2"x 8".
- Install at least 2 foundation vents for ventilation.
- Create an entrance to go underneath the stage in the back left corner.
- Install commercial grade vapor barrier on the ground underneath the stage.
- Remove all steam pipes and fill in all holes above and beneath the stage
- Build a wall around the electrical box.
- Rework existing stage light in front of stage and add 4 new lights.
- Repair damage to ceiling and walls, prime and paint; .
- Remove ductwork and install vents to the left and right at the back of the stage.
- Install prefinished hardwood floor with a vapor barrier underneath
- Build a 6"- 8" wall in front of stage to prevent wheelchairs from rolling off.
- Install vinyl siding in front of stage to match existing siding
- Labor and material cost for the stage repairs and renovations

Sealed bids will be received at the Elliott County Board of Education and the Bid Opening is scheduled for March 14, 2025 at 1:00 pm in the Board of Education Conference Room.
