a "No Play Zone" keeping kids and pets well away until grill equipment is completely cool.

- grill at least 10 feet away from other objects, including the house and any shrubs or bushes.
- · Always stay by the grill when cooking.
- for barbecue grills when starting a fire in a charcoal grill.
- the propane tank and the fuel line to be sure it is working properly and not leaking. Never use a match to check
- for leaks. If you detect a leak, immediately turn off the gas and don't attempt to light the grill again until the leak is fixed. Never bring a barbecue
