

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0
AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF HYDEN, KENTUCKY DECLARING WASTEWATER RATE

WHEREAS: this Ordinance shall apply to the City of Hyden and those who are by contract or agreement with the City, users of the City’s wastewater system

WHEREAS: the City of Hyden has determined that the current wastewater deposit rates are inadequate to maintain the system

WHEREAS: the City hereby declares wastewater rates as follows:
City resident wastewater rates shall increase from \$17.93 to \$18.54 per first two thousand gallons, and shall increase from \$6.53 to \$6.75 per additional one thousand gallons

Non-city resident wastewater rates shall increase from \$19.50 to \$20.16 per first two thousand gallons, and shall increase from \$10.04 to \$10.38 each per additional one thousand gallons

City commercial wastewater rates shall increase from \$24.20 to \$25.02 per first two thousand gallons, and shall increase from \$12.98 to 13.42 each additional one thousand gallons

Non-city commercial wastewater rates shall increase from \$27.49 to \$28.42 per first two thousand gallons, and shall increase from \$13.95 to \$14.42 per additional one thousand gallons

City and Non - City Residents will have a \$5.00 monthly maintenance fee

City and Non - City Commercial Residents will have a \$10.00 monthly maintenance fee

SECTION ONE: the City hereby declares wastewater deposits,

- (a) A \$50.00 non-refundable user fee is required from those who occupy residential rental space prior to receiving wastewater service
- (b) A \$300.00 non-refundable user fee is required from those who occupy commercial rental space prior to receiving wastewater service

SECTION TWO: Upon a disconnection of service for failure to comply with City ordinances, including, but not limited to, failure to pay timely, reconnect fees are as follows:

(1)first occurrence- \$50.00,(2) second occurrence-(3) \$75.00, third occurrence- \$100.00,(4) fourth and thereafter- \$500.00. Prior to restoration, reconnect fees must be paid at City Hall during normal business hours 8:00 AM TO 4:30 PM, Monday thru Friday.

SECTION THREE: late fee shall remain at \$10.00 plus 5% monthly on all past due accounts

SECTION FOUR: wastewater adjustment shall be considered on a case by case by the Mayor and Clerk and adjusted at time of request.

WHEREAS: be it further ordained that there shall be a mandatory wastewater hookup for all customers where wastewater service is available

WHEREAS: effective date being July 2025 wastewater billing cycle

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Hyden, Kentucky, that from and after the passage, approval, and publication of this Ordinance hereof and until repealed and/or amended thereof by the legislative body of the City that the wastewater rates be adopted into the City of Hyden. This action is taken for wastewater customers, and is pursuant to recommendation of the City of Hyden planning commission. The findings of fact of the Commission in support of this request are adopted and in full force and effect.

BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Hyden is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this Ordinance.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during the Fiscal Court Meeting at the County Court House.

Work is to include: Grading, crushed stone roadways and parking and camping amenities.

Bids will be received for a single prime contractor. Bids shall be on a unit price basis. A 5% bid bond is required.

Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Anti-Kickback Act, Non segregated facilities order 32FR 7439, and the Contract Work Hours Standard Act. This project will be in compliance with, and bidders must comply with Executive Order No. 11246 (EEO) as amended, prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Contractors & subcontractors will comply with 41 CFR 60-4, (affirmative action), to ensure equal opportunity to females and minorities and will apply the timetables and goal set forth in 41 CFR 60-4. Bidders will make positive efforts to use small, minority, women owned and disadvantaged businesses. DBE’s are encouraged to bid. The owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids.

This project is subject to Build America, Buy American Act. Davis Bacon Wage Rates are NOT applicable.
