

Shelby County resident wins Bulleit scholarship

SHELBYVILLE – Bulleit Distilling Co. awarded a \$5,000 scholarship to Shelby County resident and Jefferson Community and Technical College student Jimmy Cook.

Cook received the scholarship for the 2024-25 school year. He is studying industrial maintenance technology and holds a 3.3 GPA.
