Barkley is selected as top running back by the AP after a record-setting season

Saquon Barkley's first season in Philadelphia featured record performances on the field, a Super Bowl title and a new contract that is the richest ever for a running back.

Barkley's performance with the Eagles also helped him score the honor of being voted the top running back in the league by The Associated Press.

A panel of eight AP Pro Football Writers ranked the top five players at running back, basing selections on current status entering the 2025 season. First-place votes were worth 10 points. Second-through fifthplace votes were worth 5, 3, 2 and 1 points.

Barkley got seven first-place votes and one second to win other player selected on all eight runs of at least 60 yards.
