TIMELY TIPS FOR THE FALL CALVING HERD

Here are a few November tips that might be helpful for your fall calving herds.

Continue to watch fall-calving cows. Catch up on processing of calves including identification, castration, and vaccinations.

Cows that have calved need to go to the best pastures now! If your pastures are dried up, feed the good quality hay with an appropriate supplement to meet their daily nutrient requirements to help them maintain body condition prior to breeding in December.

If at all possible, try to get animals vaccinated 60 days or longer before the breeding season.

Start the breeding season in late November or early December for calving to begin in September. If you are using AI and/or estrus synchronization, get your supplies together now and schedule your technician.

Make final selection of replacement heifers now. Don't forget to contact your herd veterinarian to schedule a breeding soundness exam (BSE) for your bulls. All herd sires need a BSE at least

30 days before the onset of the breeding season. A BSE can be useful insurance that your bull has the physical ability to breed cows. Even though BSE's aren't perfect, they are the best tool we have to identify infertile bulls

PUBLIC NOTICE

Second reading of a proposed ordinance amending the Monroe County budget for fiscal year 2026, to include unanticipated receipts from General Fund and Road and Bridge Fund in the amount of \$418,549.27 and increasing expenditures in the area of General Fund and Road and Bridge Fund will be held on November 20, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. A copy of the proposed ordinance with full text is available for public inspection at the office of the county judge/executive during normal business hours.

FOR MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF 2024 TAX ACCOUNT AUDIT

- A statement that a copy of the complete audit report, including financial statements and supplement information, is on file at the sheriff's office and is available for public inspection during normal business hours. A statement that any citizen may obtain from the sheriff a copy of the complete audit report, including financial statements and supplemental information, for his personal use.
- A statement which notifies citizens requesting a personal copy of the audit report that they will be charged for duplication costs at a rate that shall not exceed twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per page.
- A statement that copies of the financial statement prepared in accordance with KRS 424.220 is available to the public at no cost at the business address of the officer responsible for preparation of the statement.

SUMMARY OF PROCEDURES AND FINDINGS

AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES OF THE MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF

For The Period January 1, 2024 Through December 31, 2024

The Monroe County Sheriff applied for and received approval from the Auditor of Public Accounts (APA) to obtain an Agreed-Upon Procedures (AUP) engagement for calendar year 2024 in accordance with KRS 43.070(1)(c). AUP reports present the procedures performed and the results of those procedures, called findings. The summary below presents those findings for which an exception (an instance of noncompliance with the criteria) was identified during the AUP engagement.

During the AUP engagement of the Monroe County Sheriff, the following exception was noted:

- Excess fees due to the fiscal court were recalculated and there are \$20,603 additional excess fees due to the fiscal court.

Findings related to procedures for which there were no exceptions identified, and official responses to exceptions are not included in the summary above, but can be found in the full report. A copy of this report is available on the Auditor of Public Accounts' website at auditor.ky.gov.
