BCHS Wildcats compete in indoor tract at Centre, Louisville

After more than two weeks away from competition and practice, the Bath County Wildcats wasted no time making noise as they returned to the track, competing at Centre College and the Louisville Indoor Games this past weekend—and they came back stronger than ever.
Mayme McCarty kicked things off in style, setting personal records in the 60-meter hurdles with a blazing 12.91 seconds and soaring to a new best of 10'-11" in the long jump.
Jacob Hatfield put together a huge weekend, rewriting his personal bests across the board. He clocked 7.94 seconds in the 60-meter dash, 26.32 seconds in the 200-meter, leapt 34'-3.5" in the triple jump, and added a strong 17'-11" in the long jump.
Walker Karrick continued the PR parade with standout performances of his own, jumping 14'-6" in the long jump, 33'-6.5" in the triple jump, and cutting his 60-meter hurdles time down to 10.98 seconds.
Chase Martin delivered a powerful run in the 800 meters, setting a new personal record with a time of 2:16.02.
Jonah Gibson stole the spotlight with an incredible showing, setting a new school record and personal record in the long jump at 19'-11". He followed that with a personal best of 35'-11.75" in the triple jump and a lightning-fast 7.40 seconds in the 60-meter dash—just one hundredth of a second shy of another school record.
From top to bottom, this was a meet defined by growth, grit, and resilience. Nearly every athlete walked away with personal bests, proving once again that Bath County Track & Field thrives even in the toughest of circumstances.

• Jonah Gibson – long jump, triple jump, 55-meter dash, 200-meter dash
With the regular indoor season running through February 22nd, there is still time for the picture to change—but if the momentum continues, this is shaping up to be one of the best indoor seasons in Bath County history.
