# Fiscal Court holds short special-called meeting

County Coroner Andrew Owens presented Jason Smith, newly-hired Deputy Coroner, to court members last Wednesday morning during a special-called meeting.

Bath County Fiscal Court members held a short special-called meeting last Wednesday morning.

Court members voted to:  
- approve payment to Anderson Hometown Builders for work completed at the Little League Baseball Park dugouts in the amount of \$11,900

- rescinded payment to architect firm MSE for \$33,674 from the Community-Development Block Grant Fund for the new Bath County Ambulance Service Building and approved payment for the same amount from the General Fund; County Treasurer Julie Cline explained that this payment could not be made out of federal funds and that the Bath County Ambulance Service had already sent those funds to the county's General Fund

- approved to pay custodian Kyle Watson from the county's General Fund after the new Bath County Judicial Center after April

1. Watson is currently paid by the Administrative Office of the Courts

- approved the appointment of Jason Smith as Deputy County Coroner; the current Deputy Coroner, Chad Binion, has taken on more responsibilities at his own workplace and will be sending his letter of resignation


- approved the appointment of Ian Corbin to the Bath County Memorial Library Board of Trustees, to serve out the unexpired term of Bill Judd, from

February 25 to November 1, 2026, following Judd's resignation

- approved the appointment of Michael Staton to the Bath County Extension District Board, to fill the vacancy left by the late Mike Downs, to serve from Feb. 25 to December 31, 2026

- approved the Court Facilities Local Government Reimbursement Form for the 2026 Fiscal Year in the amount of \$110,000 through June 30; Treasurer Cline explained that the cost of operating the new

Judicial Center has been recalculated for the remainder of the Fiscal Year, and the form will have to be approved against after June. County Judge/Executive Frosty McKenzie further explained that the county is responsible for the initial cost of the judicial center's upkeep, and the county is reimbursed by the Administrative Office of the Courts each fiscal quarter.
