Cathy Triplett and Cindy Bromagen Dehart inducted into 10th Region Girls' Hall of Fame

On March 22, 2026, Cathy Triplett was inducted into the 10th Region Girls' Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2026.

During's Cathy's playing years, she was a March 10th Region finalist in 1975, a March 10th Region semifinalist in 1976, and a 10th Region quarterfinalist in 1977. Cathy was one of the premier point guards in the 10th Region during the beginning of girls' basketball in the state, helping the Bath County Ladycats become one of the early powerhouses in Kentucky.

She usually led the Ladycats in assists and was a coach on the floor as a true point guard should be.

Also on March 22, 2026, Cindy Bromagen Dehart was inducted in the 10th Region Girls' Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2026. Cindy was a tenacious rebounder, tough defender in the paint, and helped lead the Bath County Ladycats to several 10th Region tournament appearances during her playing years, 1977-1980.

Congratulations to these former Ladycats for their dedication to their sport and making Bath County proud.
