

# Meeting set on Guist Creek state regulation changes

FRANKFORT — The Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources regulates boat docks and shoreline uses for 11 department-owned lakes it manages through a permit system. Department officials are planning to recommend amending these permit regulations for its lakes and will hold a series of public meetings to explain the current system and seek public input on potential changes. Permits are necessary to construct a boat dock or encroach upon the department-owned buffer zones around these state-owned lakes.

The next public meeting will concern Beaver, Elmer Davis and Guist Creek lakes in central Kentucky. The meeting is scheduled for 6:30-8 p.m. (EST) Tuesday, Feb. 24, 2026, at Capital City Christian Church, 15 Locust Drive, Frankfort, KY in the Main Worship Center. Parking will be available on the upper-level lot. Those with property interests in the area, or users of these lakes, are encouraged to participate. Beaver Lake is in Anderson County. Elmer Davis Lake is in Owen County. Guist Creek Lake is in Shelby County.

The regulation for discussion is 301 KAR 1:016, which governs boat docks and shoreline use activities at the subject lakes. A Guide for Construction on KDFWR Lakes and Land Buffer Areas is a summarization of the regulations in a more user-friendly format and can be found on the Access Structure and Private Boat Docks - Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife webpage on the department's website (fw.ky.gov). Those unable to attend public meetings may still provide comments to the Boat Dock/Shoreline Use Working

Group. Written comments may be directed to "Boat Dock/Shoreline Use Public Comment" at Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, 1 Sportsman's Lane, Frankfort, KY 40601, or by email with "Boat Dock/Shoreline Use Public Comment" in the subject line to fwboatdocks@ky.gov. Please send public comments to arrive by Friday, April 10. Commenters should include their first and last name, county and state of residence, angler or landowner designation, and organization represented with position held in the organization, if applicable.

A public meeting was held on Feb. 3 in Dry Ridge for public input on Boltz, Bullock Pen, Corinth and Kincaid lakes in northern Kentucky. Future meetings are planned for Carpenter, New Kingfisher and Old Kingfisher lakes in Daviess County, and Lake Malone in Muhlenberg, Logan and Todd counties. Dates and locations will be announced. Final recommendations incorporating public input will be presented to the Kentucky Fish and Wildlife Commission at a future meeting for further action.

# Kentucky guard Aberdeen gets dubbed 'Gator traitor' during his return game to Florida

GAINESVILLE, Fla. — Denzel Aberdeen helped Florida win a national championship last April. In his homecoming, he was dubbed a "Gator traitor."

The Kentucky guard was taunted endlessly in a 92-83 loss to the Gators. It was Aberdeen's first game in Gainesville since leaving the program and signing with a Southeastern Conference rival.

Florida fans booed him in pregame warmups and introductions. But Florida's student section, the "Rowdy Reptiles," was much harsher once the game tipped. They "welcomed" him back with chants of "Gator traitor" every time he touched the ball.

Aberdeen, who spent the previous three years at Florida, handled it well. He responded by scoring a team-high 19 points on 8-of-21 shooting. The Gators forced him to take contested shots — he missed five of six from 3-point range — and didn't let him do much else.

Aberdeen chipped in four assists, two turnovers, a steal and a rebound. "Well, Florida fans know

Denzel," Kentucky coach Mark Pope said. "Denzel is the ultimate competitor. I never worry about the lights with him. I never worry about the moment. And I never worry about the distraction because he loves to compete.

"This fanbase knows him. Of course, our fanbase loves him so much. He's

a special player."

Golden said Aberdeen's return and the backlash that comes with it are something college basketball should get used to, especially with all the freedom players have to move from place to place.

"It's a new era," Golden said. "We dabbed it up. We're cool."

Florida had several former players on hand for the sold-out game against Kentucky, including NBA rookies and Walter Clayton and Will Richard.

Clayton, the MVP of last year's Final Four, and Richard were greeted with standing ovations when they walked to their courtside seats and when they were recognized in the first half. Matt Walsh (2002-05) and Matt Bonner (1999-2003) also made the trip to Gainesville and got warm receptions.

Aberdeen can't say the same. He dumped Florida for more money and maybe a better opportunity in Lexington. While Florida made a huge deal while handing out championship rings to Clayton, Richard and Alijah Martin in person during the NBA season, the team simply shipped one to Aberdeen.

Golden may have even taken a veiled shot at Aberdeen's decision by mentioning Kentucky's "\$22 million roster" after the game.

Golden responded last year by signing Arkansas guard Boogie Fland to round out his backcourt. Fland spent much of the game guarding Otega Oweh, who finished with

13 points on 4-of-14 shooting. Aberdeen got slightly better looks — and a lot more attention.

"It was a good matchup," Florida's Alex Condon said. "I knew 'Zel was going to be aggressive tonight and try to fuel off the crowd

a little bit. Credit to him. He played a solid game and was aggressive. But our guys did a great job of making it tough, making him take tough 2s and running him off the 3-point line."

# Another big game for freshman Brown Jr. as No. 24 Louisville beats Baylor 82-71

FORT WORTH, Texas — Mikel Brown Jr. had a part of every point during Louisville's go-ahead run early in the second half as the standout freshman followed up his historic game with 29 points and six assists in the No. 24 Cardinals' 82-71 win over Baylor on Saturday.

The Cardinals (19-6) went ahead to stay with an 11-3 run that started when Brown had the assist on J'Vonne Hadley's basket with 18:20 left to snap a 39-all tie. Brown made three free throws less than a minute later after being fouled on a long shot, and then had back-to-back steals and immediately followed with assists both times — on Sananda Fru's dunk, then another jumper by Hadley. That run ended with Brown's layup with 15:06 left that made it 50-42.

Hadley finished with 20 points and Ryan Conwell had 14 for the Cardinals, who shot

56% (28 of 50) from the field. Brown was coming off 45 points in Louisville's 118-77 win over North Carolina State on Monday night, when he matched the single-game school record and broke Cooper Flagg's ACC freshman mark for a single game.

Isaac Williams had 20 points for the Bears (13-12), while freshman Tounde Yessoufou had 16. Yessoufou had 37 points in a 99-94 home loss to No. 22 BYU on Tuesday night.

The non-conference game at Dickies Arena near downtown Fort Worth was tied 34-all at halftime after Brown's long straight-up 3, his fourth and final make from beyond the arc in the game. That wrapped up a 9-2 run over the final 3 minutes for the Cardinals.
