# Identity of man killed in Jan. 20 fire remains unidentified

Woodford County Coroner Penny Baker told the Sun that the man who died in the fire at Macey Avenue on Tuesday, Jan. 20, has not been identified. Baker hopes to release the name soon, but is still awaiting forensic reports from the Kentucky State Lab.

The fire, in which there were no other

fatalities or injuries, quickly engulfed a three-story multi-family residential building in the early morning hours. Multiple first responder agencies responded, with the Versailles Fire Department (VFD) as the lead agency.

The cause of the fire has also yet to be disclosed. The Kentucky State Fire Marshal is leading the investigation with assistance from VFD.

Citizens requesting a personal copy of the audit report will be charged .25 per page for duplication costs. Copies of the financial statement prepared in accordance with KRS 424.220 are available to the public at no cost.
