LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — If the smell of Kentucky Fried Chicken roasting on an open fire appeals to you, you're in luck.

KFC tweeted on Thursday that it is offering an 11 Herbs and Spices Firelog, saying it's the best way to make your fire smell less like fire and more like chicken.

The 5-pound fire log is available on the company's website and is limited to one per customer while supplies last.

KFC says the \$18.99 fire log can burn for up to three hours, but there are some warnings that go with it: It may result in cravings for fried chicken and attract hungry neighbors or bears. And even though it smells great, it's not safe to eat.

Cocaine found in can of formula

LEXINGTON, Ky. (AP) — Police have arrested two parents after cocaine was found inside a can of their baby's formula.

Lexington police arrested Lemon Allen and Jamarra

Burnside on Wednesday. News outlets report they're charged with wanton endangerment and possession of a controlled substance.

Court documents say the two dropped off their nine-month-old son at daycare with a diaper bag in June. Police say a plastic bag of cocaine was found in a can of baby formula that belonged to Allen and Burnside's child.

Police say they found marijuana inside a baby bottle in Allen's car. Allen claimed his son never used the bottle. Police say they also found two more bottles that they suspect contain the drug serenity, along with .38 caliber bullets inside Burnside's apartment.

Kentucky House Democrats pick leadership team

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — Democrats have selected the members of their leadership team in the Kentucky House.

State Reps. Rocky Adkins, Derrick Graham and Joni Jenkins will serve for the next two years.

Adkins will be the floor leader for the Democrats, while Graham, whose district is in Franklin County, will serve as caucus chair. Jenkins, who represents southwestern Jefferson County, will be the minority whip.

A release from the Kentucky House Democratic Caucus says Graham is the first African-American to be a Democratic leader in the House.

Adkins, who represents Elliott, Lewis and Rowan counties, has announced that he is running for governor next year.
