Immediately following the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids, all proposals which have been submitted in accordance with the above conditions will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work to be bid upon is described as follows:

• Salt Lick Tank: Construction shall consist of pressure washing, tool cleaning and coating system on all interior and exterior surfaces, new roof vent, grouting around foundation and other necessary items as stated in the Specifications.
