(b) The City of Bowling Green has failed to make one of the two findings pursuant to S58.41 or to make the written determination decision required by S578.57, 58.53 or 58.64 for the project, as applicable. (c) The City of Bowling Green has omitted one or more of the steps set forth at Subparts F and G for the preparation and completion of an EA.
