"We are also observing identify and arrest imfor distracted drivers," Bivens said. "Each day in the United States, approximately nine people are killed and more than 1,000 injured in crashes that are reported to involve a distracted driver."*

Bivens urges motorists to help keep roadways safe by reporting drivers suspected of being drug or alcohol-impaired.

Call the Lewis County Sheriff's Office at 606-796-2912 or 911 to provide a direction of travel, vehicle description and a license number, if possible, to report a suspected impaired motor vehicle operator.

Callers are not required to identify themselves.

Why traffic checkpoints are publicized

If you've seen the story about traffic safety checkpoints in Lewis County (above), and the listing of locations, you've probably already wondered why that list is being publicized.

The short answer is because police agencies must advertise where the roadblocks will be held.

The longer answer has to do with a ruling by the Kentucky Supreme Court overturning a DUI conviction after determining the way roadblocks used to be conducted was a violation of state and federal constitutional rights.

Police and sheriff's departments in Kentucky must have approved roadblock sites, a supervisor has to be present, the stops must be brief, and the locations of the sites must be publicized, among others.

The US Supreme Court ruled (6-3) that checkpoints are constitutional but added they must be publicized in advance.

Without public notice, Mason County Sheriff's the brief stop at a check-Office, and Kentucky point could be considered detention without reasonable suspicion and could be a violation of your Fourth Amendment rights. The US Supreme Court has affirmed that DUI checkpoints satisfy a strong state interest in removing drunk drivers from
