"It will more than likely be the late fall and should cause little issues with service to our customers," Stone added.

"The Consumer Price Index for the current year shows that the rate of inflation is slowing and that the year-over-year rate

will increase around three percent for the current year," Stone said. "If so, we will raise water and sewer rates by around three percent, which is still a little high, but closer to the normal historic rate."

fires and the second leading cause is debris fires that escape.

If a fire escapes from the burning of debris, immediately contact the nearest Division of Forestry field office or local fire department.

The state has more than 12 million acres of forested area with almost all of them available for timber production. This acreage also provides a critical habitat for many wildlife species, including deer, turkey, elk and

black bears.
