
Donald Edwin "Don" Scott, age 93, of Willisburg, KY passed away at 8:25 p.m., Wednesday, February 21, 2024 at his home.

Darrell Scott (Penny) of Willisburg; nine grandchildren; thirteen great grandchildren and three great-great grandchildren.


Funeral services were held at 1:00 p.m., Saturday, February 24th at the Carey & Son Funeral Home with Rev. Everett Hood, officiating.
