Wireman said he would not approve it, especially given that the Half Mountain Battlefield Park, where Walnut Festival will be held on September located isvery close proximity to South Magoffin Elementary. When Wireman would not approve the band to play on county-owned property, the band then requested that the decision go to the governing body, the fiscal court.

The school board would also have to approve the band to be able to play that close to the school, Wireman said, and the schools superintendent indicated that they will not. Under Wireman's recommendations, fiscal court unanimously rejected the request to allow the individual named in the request to be

able to be within 1.000

feet of a school. The next regularly scheduled Magoffin County Fiscal Court meeting is tentatively slated for October 15 at 6 p.m. in the Magoffin County Courthouse Albert Patrick Building.
