Nicholas County Circuit Court...

Trever Lynn Gill (aka Copper King) – PRISON – sentenced to a total of 10 years imprisonment on the charges of Bur-glary in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Mischief in the 1st Degree, and Wanton Endangerment in the 1st Degree (2 counts), to be served consecutively to Mr. Gill's other sen-tences in Harrison Cir-cuit Court, Scott Circuit Court, and Fayette Cir-cuit Court. Probation was denied.

Joshua Pelkey – PRIS-ON – sentenced to a total of 2 years imprisonment on the charge of Flagrant Nonsupport. Probation was denied.

Amanda Darlene Lo-gan – PROBATION – sentenced to a total of 5 years imprisonment on the charge of Possession of a Handgun by a Con-victed Felon, to be served consecutively to Ms. Logan's other sentence in Lewis Circuit Court. Probation was granted.

James Alan Cop-page was transported to the Bourbon County Detention Center on a \$15,000.00 cash bond, as is scheduled for ar-raignment in Nicholas County District Court on Wednesday, Oct. 23, 2024, at 10:30am.

All persons are pre-sumed innocent until proven guilty or pleading guilty.

James Alan Coppage, 29, of Ky. Street, Corbin, Ky., was arrested on Fri-day, Oct. 18, 2024, by Kentucky State Police Post 06 Trooper Patrick Davis, through the ex-ecution of a complaint warrant through the Nicholas County District Court, signed by District Judge Charles Kuster on March 4, 2024. Mr. Cop-page has been charged with one count of Bur-glary, 1st Degree and one count of Possession of Firearm by Convicted Felon. Trooper Davis had no prior knowledge of this case.

According to the com-plaint warrant, Nicho-las County Sheriff Jeff Sidles states that on Feb. 7, 2024, in Nicho-las County, Kentucky, Mr. Coppage, without permission, encroached upon the premises of An-thony Vickers, located on Scrubgrass Road, and entered an outbuilding
