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DOUBLE BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT AND SINGLE BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT

This item consists of constructing Double Bituminous surface treatment composed of mat courses and seal coats. A mat course shall consist of the application of bituminous materials covered with coarse aggregate; seal coats shall consist of lighter application of bituminous materials covered with fine aggregate. A double surface treatment shall be constructed on a watered base.

Bituminous Material; Emulsified RS-2 and HFRS-2

Stone chips for Bituminous Seal Coat.

REQUIREMENTS

This material shall consist of clean, tough, durable pieces of stone, free from soft, thin, elongated, or laminated pieces; and from disintegrated stone, vegetable matter, clay, silt, or other deleterious substances. The chips shall have a percent of wear not exceeding 40%.

Stone Chips – Size No. 57's or 68's – First Course

Stone Chips – Size No. 8's or 9's – Second Course

Rate of application of bituminous material for Mat course emulsified, Asphalt used at rates of Application shall not be less than .45 or more than .55 gallon per square yard.

Application of Course Aggregate:

Aggregates shall be spread uniformly over bituminous materials with self-propelled chip spreader at rates of not less than 45 or more than 50 pounds per square yard. Spread shall closely follow the Application of Bituminous materials at the proper temperature. As soon as the Aggregates have been uniformly spread, they shall be rolled with rubber tire rollers.

SINGLE SEAL ROADS

Application of Bituminous Seal Coat Materials, the rate of application shall be .35 to .45 gallon per square yard.

Application of Seal coat Aggregate shall be uniformly spread with self-propelled chip spreader over the bituminous material at a rate of 25 to 30 pounds per square yard.

The application of chips shall closely follow the application of bituminous materials to ensure that the chips are being embedded in the bituminous material while they are still at the proper temperature. When the chips have been uniformly distributed they shall be immediately rolled with rubber tire roller.

COST:

Costs for Double Bituminous surface treatments shall include all hauling, tools, labor, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the work for this item. Bid shall be per mile of roadwork completed as in this item. Contractor will shape roads. County will furnish oil and stone

BLACKTOP—shall fall in under the same requirements. Blacktop bids should include bid for asphalt laid with paver and rolled with tack oil, as well as a bid with grader and rolled with tack oil.

Bid shall include price delivered as well as picked up at the plant.
