Fatal Collision on Interstate-165

BOWLING GREEN, KY. - At just after 2:00 P.M. Saturday, Kentucky State Police Post 03 received a call regarding a possible fatal collision.

Troopers arrived at the scene, located at the 14.4 mile marker northbound on Interstate-165.

A preliminary investigation indicates that a gray 2021 Toyota Corolla, operated by 31-year-old Alberto Alejandro Alamo Ramos of Hialeah, Florida, was traveling southbound on Interstate-165.

Mr. Ramos’s vehicle exited the roadway to the left, crossed

the grass median, and entered the northbound lane, directly into the path of a black 2020 Toyota Tacoma operated by 47-year-old Ryan Rutman of Owensboro.

Mr. Ramos was pronounced deceased at the scene by the Warren County Coroner.

A passenger in Mr. Ramos’s vehicle was transported to Bowling Green Medical Center, along with two other passengers from Mr. Rutman’s vehicle, who will be treated for their injuries.

The investigation is ongoing and is

being led by Trooper Landon Key, who was assisted at the scene by the Warren County Sheriff’s Office, Warren County EMS, the Warren County Coroner’s Office, and other KSP personnel.
