The County's health reimbursement plan was approved.

The Fiscal Court approved to pay for the Rochester Stream flow Station water gauge for \$6,000 once the job is completed to the satisfaction of the Court.

The issue of the Solar Ordinance was tabled until the next meeting.

The Fiscal Court approved the following; pay for a survey of Rochester property in the amount of \$1650, to be paid on completion, to advertise for the 2nd reading of the 25-26 budget, transfer \$35,000 from the General fund to the Jail fund, and to pay all other bills and transfers.

In the Magistrates updates; David Whittinghill, from 4th District, gave \$237.38 towards the Rochester Fireworks show.


