who also boasts eight a night, led the Bears over an undefeated Russellville team. He scored 18 with three 3's while sinking five of six from the charity stripe.

McGuyer Lee, who also possesses excellent ballhandling and shooting ability, continues to adjust his game according to the team's needs. Lee finds himself needing to be more present inside, being a force rebounding; however, do not sleep on him as his teammates and him continue to whip the ball in motion on the offensive end. Lee can light it up from outside, also.

That is just it, this adolescent group has many that will hit open shots. They move the ball well and have been finding the hot hand to generate the fast start. Helping the 7th graders average 46.4 points a night, Cameron Newcom, Cooper Hack, Rylan Woolbright, and Carter Yokubinas are all contributing regularly.

Bo Abbott, the quarterback of the football team and exceptional athlete, made his presence after an 0-3 start by the more mature group. Abbott brings a raw aspect that Coach Dockery loves working with as he gets after it defensively. Abbott's instant splash helped generate three straight wins as the coach emphasizes how the athleticism will create turnovers that end with transition buckets.

After Abbott's ten per contest, Mason Martin, who can be a monster in the middle, is an emphasis on the offensive end. Martin, who gets a half-dozen or more, has skilled footwork and can get squared up to the rim and score at will. Of course he stops the penetration-drive and rebounds exceptionally for Coach Dockery.

JT Reid-Gay, another physical

specimen, plays hard-nosed as anyone and is still learning the game. JT, who can jump out of the gym, helps speed the game for Coach Dockery while playing stifling defense and clearing boards like a man-child. A breakout offensive performance awaits, too. JT pumps in a few, nightly. Cooper Deweese, who has guard-

like handles, recently boosted his output average when he recently scored 12 at Edmonson County. The starting guard and Olsen, who comes off the bench in the second

game, both bring a six-point average as the latter has hit double-digits twice in the second game of the

Clay Amos and Deacon Phelps have started for the 8th grade bunch and both bring experience. They're teamwork and defense are solid for Coach Dockery. While neither are scoring at will (Phelps has 16 and Amos 12), they both protect and defend the basketball excellently. They will take what is given to them and play team ball.

Howie Shaffer is another player coming off the bench for Coach Dockery to help in the post area. Shaffer is strong and knows his role; he has chipped in five points on the year while providing solid defense and rebounding the basketball.

Like Olsen, Hampton, Franklin, Lee, and now Fuller, are contributing for the older squad off the bench. Hampton has scored in six of the eight and Franklin has netted points in half of the 8th games.

Fuller burst onto the scene with 11 points in Brownsville while Hampton and Franklin have tallied a total of 30 and 21, respectively.

These teams are playing good competition and thriving, night in and night out. They're learning the game from good coaches, who push them to become better. Expect these young men to continue to improve and be a team to reckon with as they find evermore continuity. They're exciting to watch; everyone needs to get out to watch them play!
