Separate Sealed BIDS for the construction of Parker Lane & US 25 South Waterline Replacement will be received by the Southern Madison Water District, 207 North Dogwood Dr., P.O. Box 220, Berea, KY 40403 until 1:00 P.M. local time, July 15, 2025, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

This contract consists of installing approximately 5,150 L.F. of 4" and 6" PVC, SDR-17 waterline and all other necessary appurtenances.

Each Bidder must accompany his/her bid with a Bid Bond in amount of not less than five (5) percent of the base bid. No Bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of 90 days. The Bidder awarded the contract shall execute a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond and shall furnish insurance as required, in the General Conditions. This contract shall be completed within <u>60 calendar days</u> after date of authorization to start work. Liquidated damages will be \$1,000 per calendar day.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375, which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Section 3, Section 109, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Anti-Kickback Act and the contract Work Hours Standard Act. Bidders must certify that they do not, and will not, maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on a basis of race, color, creed, or national origin.

Any bid that is obviously unbalanced may be rejected. The Southern Madison Water District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive informalities. Bidders must have experience with similar type projects in congested areas where multiple utilities are located. A list of references will be requested and thoroughly reviewed.

Small, minority and women's businesses and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to bid this project.
