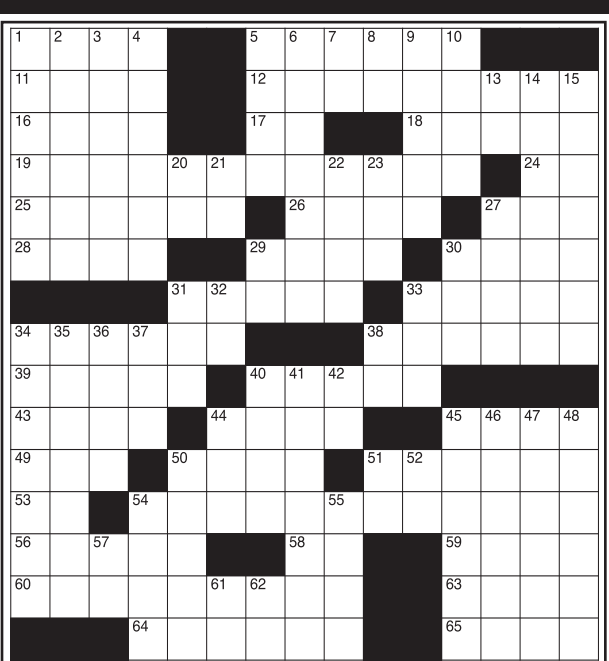
Her future plans are to attend Northern Kentucky University and get a master's in physician assistant studies.

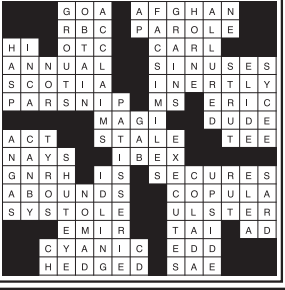
