AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF SCOTTSVILLE, KENTUCKY PROHIBITING ABANDONMENT OF VEHICLES; RESTRICTING THE DISPOSITION OR KEEPING OF WRECKED, NON-OPERATING, OR DISCARDED VEHICLES ON THE STREETS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES; AND IMPOSING PENALTIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 476 PROHIBITING ALL FREE GAS SERVICE; REQUIRING THAT THE SERVICE BE METERED; PROVIDING FOR MONTHLY BILLING; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY WHEN A BILL IS NOT PAID BY THE DUE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF BILLS AND FOR A SERVICE CHARGE FOR RESUMING SERVICE AFTER SERVICE HAS ONCE BEEN DISCONTINUED; PROVIDING FOR A SERVICE CHARGE FOR REINSTALLATION AFTER SERVICE IS VOLUNTARILY DISCONNECTED BY THE CUSTOMER; PROVIDING FOR A ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLAR (\$150.00) DEPOSIT FOR NEW SERVICE.
