DISTRICT COURT

The Allen District Court met June 18 with Judge Martha Harrison presiding.

•Jennifer Nichole Duarte was charged with speeding 23 miles per hour over the speed limit. Payment is due July 14.

•Chadrick M. Berry was charged with second-degree disorderly conduct and public intoxication of a controlled substance (excludes alcohol). Status hearing is August 6.

•Bradley Dylan Carver was charged with first-degree bail jumping. Preliminary hearing was June 25.

•Hank W. Cowles was charged with public intoxication of a controlled substance (excludes alcohol), and second-degree disorderly conduct. Payment is due October 13.

•Deborah Dawn Dority was charged with first-degree bail jumping. Preliminary hearing was June 25.

•Loretta Denise Garrett was charged with harassing communications. Credit for time served seven days.

•Timothy B. Montgomery was charged with first-degree criminal mischief, and third-degree terroristic threatening. Preliminary hearing is July 16.

•Ricky A. Moore was charged with operating on suspended or revoked operators license, no or expired registration plates, failure of non-owner operator to maintain required insurance, speeding 15 miles per hour over the speed limit, no or expired Kentucky registration receipt, no or expired registration plates, improper equipment, and failure to register transfer of motor vehicle.
