Notice is hereby given that Cumberland County Water District expects to file an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on or about June 19, 2025, seeking approval of a proposed adjustment to its water rates. The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an order approving these rates.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 5/8" X 3/4" meter tap using an average of 3,551 gallons per month will increase from \$49.52 to \$61.38. This is an increase of \$11.86 or 23.94%. If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates and an increase to the Water Loss Reduction Surcharge, then the monthly water bill for a customer using an average of 3,551 gallons per month will increase from \$52.37 to \$65.09. This is an increase of \$12.72 or 24.28%.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 1" meter tap using an average of 82,460 gallons per month will increase from \$638.81 to \$791.76. This is an increase of \$152.95 or 23.94%. If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates and an increase to the Water Loss Reduction Surcharge, then the monthly water bill for a customer using an average of 82,460 gallons per month will increase from \$641.66 to \$795.47. This is an increase of \$153.81 or 23.97%.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 2" meter tap using an average of 89,690 gallons per month will increase from \$691.62 to \$857.24. This is an increase of \$165.61 or 23.95%. If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates and an increase to the Water Loss Reduction Surcharge, then the monthly water bill for a customer using an average of 89,690 gallons per month will increase from \$694.47 to \$860.95. This is an increase of \$166.47 or 23.97%.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for Dale Hollow State Park using an average of 974,766 gallons per month will increase from \$7,198.09 to \$8,921.71. This is an increase of \$1,723.62 or 23.95%. If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates and an increase to the Water Loss Reduction Surcharge, then the monthly water bill for Dale Hollow State Park using an average of 974,766 gallons per month will increase from \$7,200.94 to \$8,925.42. This is an increase of \$1,724.48 or 23.95%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Cumberland County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.

Cumberland County Water District has available for inspection at its office the application which it submitted to the Public Service Commission. A person may examine this application at the District's office located at 133 Lower River Street, Burkesville, KY 42717. You may contact the office at (270) 864-3133.

A person may also examine the application at the Public Service Commission's offices located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40601, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the Public Service Commission's website at <http://psc.ky.gov>. Comments regarding the application may be submitted to the Public Service Commission through its website or by mail to Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40602. You may contact the Public Service Commission at 502-564-3940.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, KY, 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the application.

KSP Arrests Man in Metcalfe after Interviewing a Louisville Man in Cumberland County

Metcalfe County Sheriff's Office requested Kentucky State Police (KSP) Post 15 Troopers investigate a reported shooting June 19, 2025, at 3:48pm. Reportedly, gunshots were heard fired near a residence on Summer Shade Road in Metcalfe County. As Troopers responded to the residence, they learned a man with a gunshot wound had arrived at the Cumberland County Hospital in Burkesville.

Troopers then responded to the hospital and spoke with Nicholas Marzette, 33, of Louisville. The preliminary investigation alleges that Noah Neal, 27, of Willow Shade, and Marzette were involved in an altercation at the residence before Neal discharged

a firearm, and Marzette was struck twice. Marzette had been transported to the Cumberland County Hospital for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries.

After the preliminary investigation, Neal was arrested and charged with assault 1st degree

and discharge of a firearm across a public road, as well as a probation violation.

Neal was lodged in the Adair County Detention Center. Senior Trooper Brandon Poole continues his investigation of this case.
