

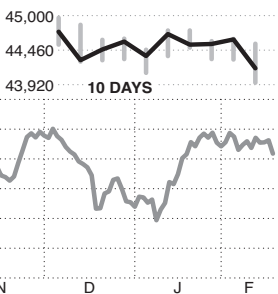

situations for applying for Medicare:

1. Turning 65 and receiving your Social Security:
 - You should receive your "Welcome to Medicare" kit by mail with your new Medicare card 90 days prior to turning 65.
2. Turning 65 and NOT receiving your Social Security check (this is Jodie's situation):
 - You do not get an automatic "Welcome to Medicare" kit with your Medicare card.
 - You must visit SSA.gov to enroll in Medicare 90 days prior to turning 65 for your Medicare Parts A and B to begin the first day of the month you turn 65.
3. Turning 65 and still working with employer's benefits:
 - Medicare allows you to delay your Medicare if you (or your spouse) are working full-time with

employer benefits (not retirement benefits).

If you think you are confused about how to enroll in Medicare when turning 65, wait until you jump into the maze of Medicare health and prescription drug plan options. Remember, when it comes to Medicare, what you don't know WILL hurt you.

Trump administration takes aim at \$4B in funding for Calif. high-speed rail

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) The Trump administration is once again targeting California's controversial high-speed rail project, with federal transportation officials on Thursday announcing an investigation and possible withdrawal of about \$4 billion in federal funding. Voters first approved \$10 billion in bond money in 2008 for a project designed to shuttle riders between

San Francisco and Los Angeles in less than three hours. It was slated to cost \$33 billion and be finished by 2020. But the project has been beset by funding challenges, cost overruns and delays. Now, state officials are focused on a 171-mile (275-kilometer) stretch connecting the Central Valley cities of Bakersfield and Merced, which is set to be operating by 2033. The entire San Fran-

cisco to Los Angeles line will now cost an estimated \$106 billion to finish. "I am directing my staff to review and determine whether the (California High-Speed Rail Authority) has followed through on the commitments it made to receive billions of dollars in federal funding. If not, I will have to consider whether that money could be given to des-

serving infrastructure projects elsewhere in the United States," Transportation Secretary Sean Duffy said at a news conference in Los Angeles. President Donald Trump canceled nearly \$1 billion in federal funding for the high-speed rail project in 2019, during his first term. The Biden administration later restored the funding and, in December 2023, allocated \$3.3 billion more.
