"This is a pivotal moment in the fight against Alzheimer's; there are now treatments that can slow the progression of the disease in the early stages," Shannon White, executive director of the Greater Kentucky and Southern Indiana chapter of Alzheimer's Associations, said. "Now more than ever, we need to work to advance

disease research and treatments that can help all Kentucky families affected by Alzheimer's and other dementia."

The walk will honor those affected by Alzheimer's and will have a Promise Garden ceremony. Walkers will carry flowers, each color representing their connection to the disease.

The event opens at 1:30 p.m., the ceremony will start at 2:15 and the walk directly after.
