County Clerk Kevin Alexander reported the tax bill sale is set for September 16 of Sept. at 11:00am. If they buy the tax bill, they can charge up to 12% and add attorney's fees. Alexander stated there is a bill being introduces that has to do with delinquent tax bills on properties of someone who is deceased, that owes tax bills, so they can be foreclosed on and give the money back to the county that is owed. This will allow for years of the property's delinquent taxes to be bundled together

The parks and rec report was given by Cody Stewart. Stewart said little league soccer has started. Halloween on the Square preparation is underway.

In new business; the fiscal court approved the following: advertise for part time parks custodian; treasurer's August monthly

settlement report; appointed Josh Casey to recreation tax committee for a one-year term starting on Sept. 8, 2025; appointed Alicia Edwards to recreation tax committee for a two-year term starting Sept. 8, 2025; approved to reappoint Phillip Coleman to recreation tax committee for a two-year term starting on Sept. 27, 2025; approved to advertise for Sunfish Roundhill Road project bill; approved to move the Oct. 13, 2025 fiscal court meeting to Oct. 14, and to purchase a salter and plow for the 2024 Dodge Ram 5500.

The fiscal court acknowledged Edmonson Ambulance District 2025 tax rates, Big Reedy Watershed

Conservancy District annual financial report, and August dog control CAD report.

The fiscal court tabled Edmonson County Public Library's 2025 tax rates at this time.

The Fiscal Court approved the sheriff's August monthly excess fee report pending final audit.

In updates Magistrate TJ Massey asked about blackout. Montgomery stated that Cleary's was easier to work with than Scott's, but the blackout is soft. He has finished up but is still looking at flex roads and add-ons.

All other bills and budget transfers were approved.

The entertainment hearing will be on Sept. 22, 2025, at 3:30 pm.

The next fiscal court will be on Sept. 22, 2025, at 4:00pm in the upstairs courtroom.
