**Continued from Page 1** ing requirement, enacted during the 2021 General Assembly, aims to increase highway safety by ensuring that drivers maintain good vision throughout their years of driving. Drivers who do not pass the free initial screening at a Driver Licensing Regional Office will need to see a vision specialist for a secondary examination and possible corrective measures. If approved for renewal, they will then be able to return to a regional office with a certification form completed by their vision specialist.

House Bill 439, signed into law by Gov. Beshear after the state legislature passed it during the 2021 legislative session, took effect on January 1, 2025.

Screenings can be completed at no cost at any Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) Driver Licensing Regional Office at the time of license renewal. Vision screenings at the time of renewal, on average, take less than one minute to complete.

Although not required, appointments for driver's license renewals are strongly recommended. State law allows residents to renew their licenses up to 180 days before their expiration date. Kentuckians are advised to renew early should they need any corrective measures to improve their vision while their current licenses are still valid. Drivers 21 years old or older can renew their driver's license for four or eight years.
