The fees contained in this notice are the fees to be proposed by Kentucky-American Water Company to the Public Service Commission no later than March 1, 2025, to be effective on March 31, 2025. The current fee, which applies to Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Other Public Authority and Sales for Resale customers, is \$0.0298 per 100 gallons. The requested fee, which applies to the same customer classes as the current fee, is \$0.0316 per 100 gallons. For all customer classes to which the fee applies, the requested fee is an increase of \$0.0018, or 6.04%, per 100 gallons. Average usage, in hundreds of gallons, for each customer class to which the fee applies is: Residential: 38; Commercial: 355; Industrial: 18,327; Other Public Authority: 1,294; and Sales for Resale: 11,837. The effect on the average monthly bill for each customer class to which the increased fee applies is: Residential: \$0.07; Commercial: \$0.64; Industrial: \$32.99; Other Public Authority: \$2.33; and Sales for Resale: \$21.31. Customers in Eastern Rockcastle County are not charged the fee, therefore are excluded from the calculation. MOON **PHASES:** March begins with the moon in the light phase where it continues until the full moon at 2:55 a.m.

When the light moon is in force, plant aboveground producers and it's below-ground producers when the dark moon rules.

Don't plant when either of the killing signs, Aries and Leo, is in force or veggies when the flowering signs Virgo and Libra rule since they are bloom days.

Planting when the fertile signs rule is a viable alternative to the VERY fertile signs, which are Scorpio, Pisces, Taurus, and Cancer. The fertile ones – just a little below VERY fertile - are Sagittarius, Capricorn, and Aquarius.

If you can only utilize one aspect of the system for planting, I would suggest going with the moon phases but still completely avoid the killing signs Aries and Leo and the flowering signs Virgo and Libra for anything but flowers.

THE SIGNS: Check to see if the moon is in the light or dark phase (information above and on any calendar) before planting anywhere, or other moonrelated activities. Since March begins with killing days ruling, that's where we will begin.

KILLING DAYS: Aries/head, March 1-2, 28-29; Leo/heart, March 9-11. There are seven days ruled by the two killing signs during March.

VERY FERTILE Taurus/neck, **DAYS:** March 3-4, 30-31, above-grounders; Cancer/breast, March 7-8, above-grounders; Scorpio/secrets, March 17-18,
