KY American Water says protect pipes in cold weather

With winter weather upon us, Kentucky American Water is sharing handy cold weather tips with customers to help them avoid costly repairs and unwanted stress from frozen pipes.

To prepare, customers should: Know how to shut off your water: Locate your main water shut-off valve. In many homes, it is located close to where the water pipe enters the home, such as in a utility closet, basement or crawl space. Hang an I.D. tag on the valve so it can be found quickly during an emergency. Test your main water shut-off valve: Once located, test the shut-off valve by closing it. Once completely closed, check sinks and other water fixtures to ensure the shut-off valve is

working properly.

Ball valves generally only require a quarter turn to close.

Gate valves are generally closed by turning the handle clockwise and should turn easily.

If the valve does not close easily, it may need to be serviced.

Bonus: After testing your shut-off valve, check the incoming water service line that is connected to it to determine the material the pipe is made of. Visit www.amwater.com/kyaw/Water-Quality/Lead-and-Drinking-Water to learn more about Kentucky American Water's service line identification program and how you can participate.

Check sprinkler or irrigation systems: Make sure everything is turned off and fully drained.

Eliminate sources of cold air near water lines: Check for pipes in areas

that might be prone to freezing, such as crawl spaces, unheated rooms, basements, garages, and exterior walls. Fix drafty windows, insulate walls around pipes and plug drafts around doors.

Protect your pipes: Where pipes are exposed to cold, wrap them with insulation or heat tape (even fabric or newspaper can help).

When temperatures stay below freezing: Give pipes a helping hand: If pipes run through cabinets or vanities, open the doors to let warmer room temperatures flow in.

Keep water moving through the pipes: Allow a small trickle of water to run. The cost of the extra water is typically lower than the cost of repairing a broken pipe.

If pipes freeze:

Shut off the water immediately: Do not attempt to thaw pipes without turning off the main water shut-off valve.

Thaw a frozen pipe by warming the air around it: Use a hair dryer, space heater or hot water. Do not leave space heaters unattended and avoid using kerosene heaters or open flames.

Once pipes are thawed: Slowly turn the water back on. Check pipes and joints for any cracks or leaks potentially caused by freezing.

When customers are away from home, consider the following: Set your thermostat at 55 degrees to prevent freezing.

Have a friend, relative or neighbor regularly check the property to help ensure the heat is working and the pipes have not frozen.
