AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF STAMPING GROUND, KY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING

FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT
WHEREAS, the Stamping Ground City Commission adopted the annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 as Stamping Ground Ordinance 2024-004; and
WHEREAS, after review of transactions through the fiscal year as approved

by the City Commission it is necessary to amend the City's budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025;

CREATING AND ESTABLISHING FOR BID A NON-EXCLUSIVE GAS FRANCHISE FOR THE PLACEMENT OF FACILITIES FOR THE TRANSMISSION, DISTRIBUTION AND SALE OF GAS FOR HEATING AND OTHER PURPOSES WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN FOR AN INITIAL TEN (10) YEAR PERIOD WITH UP TO TWO (2) ADDITIONAL EXTENSIONS OF TIME OF FIVE (5) YEARS EACH, RESERVING THE RIGHT TO IMPOSE A FRANCHISE FEE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF EACH FRANCHISEE'S GROSS ANNUAL REVENUES FROM THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION,
