GROUND ORDINANCE NO. 2025-

AN ORDINANCE RE-

LATING TO AD VALOREM TAXES

Be it ordained by the City of Stamping Ground, Kentucky as follows:

Section 1. The 2025 tax rate for all real property located within the city limits of Stamping Ground, Kentucky shall be 13.5 cents

per \$100.00 of assessed value.

Section 2. The 2026 tax rate for all personal property located within the city limits of Stamping Ground, Kentucky shall be 13.5 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value.

Section 3. The 2026 tax rate for all vehicles and watercraft within the city limits of Stamping Ground, Kentucky shall be 40.0 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
