

Square Improvements



The 2025 Greensburg Square improvements consisted of a retaining wall and steps located at the corner of West Court Street and the Greensburg Square. Work was completed last week with Scott & Murphy, Inc., of Bowling Green, in charge of construction and engineering work done by Pitman Green, LLC of Greensburg.

Fiscal Court

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(2) To authorize Judge-Executive John Frank to sign the Memorandum of Agreement between the Lake Cumberland Area Development District (LCADD) and Green County Fiscal Court regarding the Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program;

(3) Resolution No. 06-19-2025, regarding the discontinuance and closure of a portion of Brushy Road, a distance of 411 feet and the appointment of “viewers,” namely County Road Supervisor Daryl Rogers, Delbert Graham, and Raymond Stillwell.

(4) Resolution No. 06-19-2025-01, to provide publication and public notices of the proposed partial closure of Brushy Road and a public hearing;

(5) To authorize Judge-Executive Frank to sign documents regarding easement for Shallow Creek Road;

(6) Resolution No. 06-19-2025-2, regarding the discontinuance

and closure of a portion of Shallow Creek Road, a distance of 840 feet and the appointment of “viewers,” namely County Road Supervisor Daryl Rogers, Delbert Graham, and Raymond Stillwell;

(7) Resolution No. 06-19-2025-3, to provide publication and public notices of the proposed partial closure of Shallow Creek Road and a public hearing;

“The Court had requests regarding two different partial road closures. These closures have to be dealt with and handled a certain way to abide by state law. We will begin the process of partial county road closures on Brushy Road and Shallow Creek Road,” said Judge Frank.

(8) The effective date of pay raises for Emergency Management Director and Deputy Director beginning July 1, 2025;

(9) To authorize

Judge-Executive John Frank to sign various projects application and other documents for KY House Bill 1 of \$2 million;

(10) To authorize Judge-Executive Frank to sign and execute resolution for filing of KY House Bill 1 Project Grant;

(11) To open checking account for House Bill 1 regarding various projects with John Frank, Andrea Durrett, Sharon Abell, and Anne Beard as signers on account;

(12) To award the Reverse Salt Auction bid of \$132.50 per ton to Morton Salt, of Cincinnati, Ohio for the purchase of road salt for the upcoming winter months;

(13) To hire an employee for the months of June, July, and August at the Old Courthouse at a cost of up to \$12 an hour, 3 days a week, 4 hours a day;

(14) To change time worked by the Admin-

istrative Assistant to two days a week with the option of working a third day if needed;

(15) To extend the Building Inspector contract through the month of August, 2025;

(16) To reappoint Charlie Allen to the Green Country Ambulance Board effective July 23, 2025-July 22, 2027;

(17) To accept a check of \$20,000 from the Industrial Development Authority for the benefit of the American Legion Park;

(18) The acknowledgement of the ambulance district budget for fiscal year 2025-2026;

(19) The acknowledgement of the Green County Public Library budget for fiscal year 2025-2026.
