



Watson understands how frustrating a 4-8 season was for UK last year. His first season at Marshall the team went 6-7 and then came back to win the Sun Belt Conference championship in 2024. "We wore 6-7 shirts all

season at Marshall to remind

us that we did not want to feel that way again," Watson said. "That's why Kentucky's record last year did not concern me at all.'

Watson's journey has not been easy. He originally committed to LSU but then flipped to TCU because he could not make an official visit to LSU during COVID and he had been to TCU multiple times."

He played sparingly his

first three years — two at TCU, one at Marshall — and admits it was a "humbling" experience that will motivate him at UK.

"I think every highly recruited player expects to play right away and not getting to play was very humbling," Watson said. "Now I want to prove people wrong and show I can play in the SEC."

Watson believes Stoops and his staff are as motivated as he is and want to see a dramatic improvement in this year's team.

"The little things that they probably let slide last year, they're not letting slide this year. I like that," he said. "All the coaching staff seem to have a chip on their shoulder and so do us players as well because we know we're better than a lot
