## Restaurant offers free food during recent storm

EMINENCE — Puckett's Family Restaurant came to the rescue of those in Eminence who lost power or were unable to get to the grocery store during the recent snow storm.

Owner James Puckett said on a Facebook post last Sunday afternoon as the weather worsened, "The snow is here and we have no idea what to expect. What we do know

is if we can help, we will. "Currently we are at the restaurant trying to clean and prep a few things. By 2 p.m. on Sunday we should have a couple of our soups

ready. So we will be here if anyone loses power (and we still have power) and all are welcome."

Puckett said that the food, coffee, and phone charging were

all free. He praised the road crews and said the restaurant would be open as long as it was needed.

General Manager Brad Frazier said the restaurant had four tables used

during the evening and went one better than the offer of soup and coffee.

"We opened the whole menu to them and it was all free," Frazier said.

The restaurant stayed open until around 10 p.m. after everyone left.

This is not the first time the restaurant has gone the extra mile to serve the community.

During the last tornado that hit Henry County, it delivered free meals to those affected by the storm and to emergency workers.

During one of the recent general elections, the restaurant delivered

a free, full hot breakfast to all precinct workers throughout the county.

The restaurant is located at 4881 N. Main St. in Eminence.
