### PUBLIC NOTICE

Summer Shade Solar, LLC, is proposing to construct and operate an approximately 106 MW photovoltaic solar energy electric generating and battery storage project and related transmission line (the "Project") in Metcalfe County, Kentucky. The Project will be located to the west of State Highway 163 (KY-163) and near Summer Shade Road and Apple Grove Road. A public meeting to inform the community about the project and answer questions about the project will take place on January 29, 2025, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Central Standard Time in the Fiscal Court meeting room in the Metcalfe County Government Building at 201 N Main St. in Edmonton, KY 42129. The proposed photovoltaic solar energy project will consist of solar photovoltaic panels and the associated racking systems, electric equipment, project substation and transformer, utility switching station, battery storage system, and underground and overhead electrical connection lines. The power generated by the Project will be linked to the electric transmission grid via the 161 kilovolt (kV) Summer Shade Substation owned by East Kentucky Power Cooperative.
