Summer Shade Solar, LLC, is proposing to construct and operate an approximately 106 MW photovoltaic solar energy electric generating and battery storage project and related transmission line (the "Project") in Metcalfe County, Kentucky. The Project will be located to the west of State Highway 163 (KY-163) and near Summer Shade Road and Apple Grove Road. The power generated by the Project will be linked to the electric transmission grid via the 161 kilovolt (kV) Summer Shade Substation owned by East Kentucky Power Cooperative. 
