OF ORDINANCE 920.45

Comes the undersigned, an attorney practicing in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and pursuant to KRS 83A.060(4) and (9), has prepared the following summary for reading and publication of the Ordinance so titled above, amending Ordinance 920.27.

The City of Stanford, Kentucky shall henceforth allow recreational vehicles as defined and legally permitted, pursuant to the provisions of the amendment of existing Ordinance 920.27.

The amendment specifies the details for the issuance of permits, and the cost thereof. and defines violations of said amendment, with punitive provisions as follows:

"9. Fines and penalties.

a. Failure to obtain a permit shall result in a ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) PER DAY FINE.

Violations of this ordinance shall result in a ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) PER DAY FINE.

b. Each day of a violation shall be construed as a new violation The Lot owner shall be responsible for the penalty, which may be enforced by lien on the real property on which the occupied recreational vehicle is located." FIRST READING: April 10, 2025 SECOND READING: May 8, 2025
