Put on by Hopkinsville Parks and Recreation, Hopkinsville Planters Bank-Jennie Stuart Sportsplex hosted the event from 9am-3pm for the third consecutive year, according to Heather Shoemake from Holiday Inn & Suites Hopkinsville Convention Center, an annual participant.

"[The flow has] been steady; usually between 1-3pm is when it really picks up," Shoemake said.

Eighty vendors were represented at the 2025 fair, including handcrafted items and food trucks. Everything from homemade jam, bandanas, refrigerator magnets, bird baths, wooden bowls and cutting boards, jewelry, greeting cards, popcorn, pocketknives and keychains could be found all in one place.

"I've been doing [Christmas in July] since it started," vendor Lisa Ewer said. "I enjoy being able to set up for local events. I want to have a presence in the community, so I enjoy the opportunity to be able to have that here, and I also love to do an indoor show in July!"

What makes people keep coming back to Christmas in July is the uniqueness of the items and creativity of the people to be found there. One customer, Kitty Calhoun, said she enjoyed the 2024 Christmas in July fair, which is why she returned in 2025.

"You can find stuff here that you're not gonna see anywhere else," Calhoun said.

Christmas in July 2025 celebrated another successful fair to showcase small businesses, local artists and chefs. They hope to continue annually, bringing the community together.
