including with maintenance staff on facility needs, Jessica Castenir for financial and budget issues, the Green County Transportation Director to find solutions to the district's driver training issues and admins at each school to address issues as needed. She also hired an additional counselor at the middle school and an additional School Resource Officer and attended monthly business meetings, graduation planning meetings, various working sessions, meetings to discuss the 2025-26 budget and salary raises with finance and other statewide conferences.

Collaborative Leadership is the sixth standard. It tasks the superintendent to maintain a positive relationship with all board members as they work together to establish community support for the district's goals through effective twoway communications with students, staff, parents, business representatives, government leaders, community members and the media.


