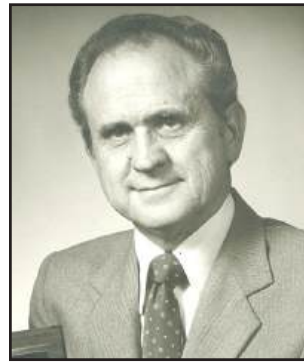
## Rev. George W. Phillips
