Notice is hereby given that on January 13, 2025 Sunshine Oil & Gas, LLC, 458 North Main Street, Madisonville, Kentucky 42431 filed an application with the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources, Division of Oil and Gas to convert the Jeremy Howe et al. Well No. 2 21-26 to a Class II enhanced recovery water injection well. The legal location (Carter Coordinate) of the proposed injection well is 843' from the South line (FSL) and 1,093' from the West line (FWL) of Section 25-12-19 in Muhlenberg County, Kentucky.

Injection shall be confined to the Warsaw Formation from 2,356' to 2,450'. The maximum injection pressure will be 2,387.6 psi at a maximum rate of 200 barrels per day.
