AN ORDINANCE
DECLARING PARCELS
OF LAND TO HAVE
BEEN DEDICATED
AS PUBLIC WAYS,
PURSUANT TO KRS
82.400(3); ACCEPTING
SUCH DEDICATIONS;
AND NAMING SUCH AS
“GOLF CART LANE”
AND “CLUBVIEW
DRIVE”

IT IS HEREBY
ORDAINED BY THE
CITY OF CENTRAL
CITY, KENTUCKY, AS
FOLLOWS:

1. The parcels of property which are thirty (30) feet in width, described below, are the subject of this Ordinance:

The subject parcels, thirty feet in width, are connected to one another and located along approximately 330 feet from Front Street/ Kentucky State Highway 70 northeast of Country Club Drive N 47 degrees 20’41” E 104.50 feet; thence N 35 degrees 34’29” E 134.74 feet, thence N 35 degrees 33’05” E 265.69 feet (at this point the public way becomes “Clubview Drive”); thence S 56 degrees 14’21” E 145.39 feet; thence S 79 degrees 38’52” W 61.59 feet; thence N 35 degrees 32’05” 313.69 feet; thence S 54 degrees 27’55” 30.00 feet; thence

S 35 degrees 32’05” W 313.69 feet; thence S 79 degrees 38’52” W 107.79 feet; thence S 56 degrees 14’21” E 67.54 feet (at this point the public way becomes “Golf Cart Lane”); thence S 79 degrees 39’22” W 61.58 feet; thence S 35 degrees 33’05” W 198.17 feet; thence S 35 degrees 34’23” W 134.22 feet; thence S 50 degrees 17’46” W 149.26 feet; thence N 05 degrees 16’16” 46.96 feet to the point of beginning

2. The herein above described parcels are hereby declared, pursuant to KRS 82.400(3) to have been dedicated to the City of Central City, Kentucky as a public way or easement, the city council having found that they have been opened to the unrestricted use of members of the general public for at least five consecutive years prior to the date of the first reading of this ordinance. The location of these public ways or easements are marked on the plat attached hereto as an exhibit.

3. Said parcels of land are hereby accepted, pursuant to KRS 82.400(3) as existing public way or easement, and are therefore declared to be a city street for all purposes.

4. Request for dedication of the above-described streets by the affected property owners is attached hereto.

5. The requirements of Ordinance KOC #620.13, relating to new street construction, shall not apply to any improvements made by the City of Central City to the streets accepted herein, as any such improvements financed. By the City shall be improvements to existing streets, and not construction of new streets.

6. Said public ways accepted herein shall

henceforth be know as “Golf Cart Lane” and “Clubview Drive”.

7. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
